Beginning in the fall 2010 all players in the age groups U15-U19 will be required to show a Player ID Card, similar to a Coaches Card, before each game to the referee before they are allowed to play. True or False?

Answer: True

Beginning in the fall 2010 referees will NOT return Game Reports to the teams in the U11-U12 age group after the game. Referees will submit the game report to the association by placing the report in "bucket" at the field after the game. True or False?

Answer: True

Feinting is allowed in the run-up in the taking of a penalty kick, however once the player reaches the ball feinting is no longer allowed. True or False?

True: It is now considered an infringement of Law 14 and act of unsporting behavior and the player should be cautioned.

Before a penalty kick was taken, the goalkeeper moved to his/her right and then to his/her left, but remained on the goal line. The kick was taken and the goalkeeper deflected the ball over the crossbar. As the referee, you should restart play with a:

- A. Corner Kick
- B. Goal Kick
- C. Throw-In
- D. Dropped Ball
- E. Kick-off

Answer: A. Corner Kick

Reason: The keeper is allowed to move side to side before the kick as he has to remain on the line.
