If a teammate of the goalie deliberately kicks the ball to his goalie, who is outside the penalty area, may the goalie dribble the ball back into the penalty area and pick it up with the hands? What is the restart and where?

Answer: No, because the goalkeeper cannot use the hands to play a ball last kicked by a teammate. Restart is an indirect kick where the infraction occurred

Is there any exception to this?

Answer: Yes, if the ball bounces off an opponent on the way to the 'keeper, the 'keeper may dribble it into the penalty area and pick it up.

Can a goalie dribble the ball into the penalty area and then pick it up with hands after the ball was kicked to him by an opponent?

Answer: Yes.

Can you continue a game if a team has the minimum number of players and one player on this team gets injured and comes off the field?

Answer: Yes if you can determine that the player who was injured will return to play soon after the injury. If not, then you abandon the game and record on the Game Report.
