



Recertification for 2011

It will not be long before you will need to recertify for 2011.

If you want to referee in 2011 and your badge has 2010 on it you must recertify. Mark your calendar as we will be offering a clinic at the Carrollton City Library (Josey and Hebron) on December 20, 2010 beginning promptly at 6:00PM. The clinic should last about 2 hours. No sign up required, however space is limited to 90 attendees. This will be the only recertification clinic that CFBSA will host. If you are unable to attend our clinic you can take a clinic at any other association. Please check the N. Texas web site for additional information.

You will need to take some time and review the laws of the game. Also remember that the exam is geared towards full-sided, full length FIFA games. I encourage you to please brush up on offside, fouls and misconduct and restarts.

This year, like last year, US Soccer will be sending you your 2011 Badge and Law Book - you will not get them after you take the recertification exam.

Grade 8 Referees: You will be required to take and pass a 100 question exam this year. You need to be prepared for a longer than usual grading and registration period. Grade 9 Referees: You will be required to take and pass 50 question exam, same as in the past. The fee to be recertified will be \$45.00, paid at the end of the clinic.

I have been told the on-line recertification process has some "bugs" and isn't being rolled out this time.
