



## **CFBSA COACHES QUICK REFERENCE GUIDELINES**

**Your CFBSA League Director is your first contact person for all questions except rainouts!**

Head Coaches are responsible for their spectators and coaches' behavior as well as their players

Referee abuse may result in a minimum of 3 game suspension and a fine

It is the responsibility of the Head Coach to contact each and every player assigned to their team. Once notified of an addition the coach has 48 hours to contact that player and let them know about practices and scheduled games. If the Head Coach has difficulty contacting the player/parents he/she must notify their league director, their sided VP and the VP of Coaches and Referees. Failure to follow these guidelines will result in a 3 game suspension on the first suspension, and may lead to up to a year suspension for any further failure.

Running up the score on your opponent is not allowed and may result in, however not limited to, fine, suspension and loss of points in standings

All games are considered "on" and playable unless specified on website and/or CFBSA phone message. Weekday games may be cancelled by the city as late as 4:00 P.M

Failure to adhere to CFBSA Nets/Flags Policy may result in, however not limited to, fine, suspension and loss of points in standings.

Clock starts at game time

Jersey colors must match (no exception). Home teams must have "cover ups" or alternate jerseys if opposing team has same and/or similar color.

Home team players and visiting team players and coaches must sit on the same side of the field as each other. Parents/spectators of their respective teams must sit on opposite side of the field

All rostered coaches/asst/mgrs (maximum 3) may be in coaching area and **must** visibly display coaches' badges to be on sideline with players.

All players must play 50% of each game

All players are required to wear shin guards and proper footwear

Home team to provide game ball

Game scores must be submitted no later than 48 hours after game

Both the home **and** visiting teams must complete game reports for each game. Need to be filled out and completed & signed by the referee and both coaches

Game Reports must be faxed, e-mailed or mailed and received no later than 48 hours after game. U13-U19 team need to follow Northern Mid Cities Guidelines and Procedures listed on web site

For **ALL NON** CFBSA field closings you must check the home association in which the game is scheduled for play.
