



Coaches Code of Conduct

The following are some of the basic rules that are found in the organizational playing rules that all coaches must adhere to:

1. Play games as scheduled. At no time will I circumvent the scheduling of games. All city fields are for CFBSA scheduled games only. They are not to be used as practice fields.
2. All players attending a game will be played a minimum of 50% of game time remaining.
3. All scheduling requests must be submitted to cupsgamescommittee@cfbsoccer.net designated person as identified at the beginning of each soccer season, in writing, at least 3 weeks prior to the start of each season or designated date by CFBSA. After the start of the season, the only circumstances that may be considered for re-schedules shall be: weather related, city related or school related. CFBSA will do its best to honor your request. However, this is not a guarantee it will be honored. One (1) request per soccer season may be honored by CFBSA.

5. Adhere to CFBSA Nets and Flag Policy found at www.cfbsoccer.net
6. In the spirit of good sportsmanship it is recommended that coaches endeavor to refrain from running up the score on opposing teams, as this can interpreted as unsporting behavior. We want the soccer experience to be enjoyable for everyone.
7. Adhere to North Texas State Soccer Association (NTSSA) Coaches Code of Ethics/Conduct located at www.ntxsoccer.org
8. It is the responsibility of the Head Coach to contact each and every player assigned to their team. Once notified of an addition the coach has 48 hours to contact that player and let them know about practices and scheduled games. If the Head Coach has difficulty contacting the player/parents he/she must notify their league director, their sided VP and the VP of Coaches and Referees. Failure to follow these guidelines will result in a 3 game suspension on the first suspense, and may lead to up to a year suspension for any further failure.
