



## **Revised (3/29/2009) Nets and Flag Procedure-Cox and Pepper Fields**

If you are playing at **Cox or Pepper** the procedure has slightly changed, effective 3/29/2009. If you're the **home** team **and** it is the **first** game of the day it is your responsibility to go to the storage room located at the Cox concession stand and retrieve two nets/four flags for your game. If you're the **home** team **and** it is the **last** game of the day on the field you are playing it is your responsibility to return the equipment to the Cox concession stand storage room. However, it is now the responsibility of **both** the home and visiting teams to set up and take down the equipment. This applies to only CFBSA teams, **not** the traveling teams.

If playing at Pepper or Cox the equipment will be stored in the storage closet located at the Cox Concession Stand. Cox Field is north of Pepper on Dennis Lane. The concession stand is located on the south side of Cox Field and will be open 30 minutes prior to the 1st scheduled game.

In the storage room at Cox you will find a mesh bag containing two nets per field. The bag containing two nets is labeled with the field number/age group. Take the nets for the field you're playing on and **any** 4 corner flags to your game field and place the empty bag **inside** the goal at the field you are playing. If you play at Cox place your empty bag in the goal **closer** to the concession stand. For Pepper, place your bag in the goal closer to Dennis Lane. If the game is cancelled or called early then all equipment is to be collected by **both** CFBSA teams and returned to the storage area by the home team at that time. **Stakes** are available to secure the nets at Pepper and Cox. Please take 6 stakes from the storage room for each field and return at the end of the day.

Never take the nets/flags home with you unless for some reason you are the last team and the storage closet is locked. Do not leave the nets/flags, as they would be easy to steal. In any event you leave with the flags/nets, notify the soccer office, your league director, and [vpcupsgames@cfbsoccer.net](mailto:vpcupsgames@cfbsoccer.net) so CFBSA can get these from you quickly as nets/flags will certainly be needed, probably the next day!

First/last game schedule is posted on our web-site [www.cfbsoccer.net](http://www.cfbsoccer.net). However, if **no** team or if only one team takes the field after your game the home team must return the equipment to the storage closet immediately after the game. As a courtesy we ask everyone to keep the storage area clear of all litter and return the equipment to the appropriate location. If your equipment is missing do not use another field's equipment as the different age groups have different size nets. **You will need to come back to the field the same day if you leave the equipment up!**
