



Revised - (3/29/200) Nets and Flag Procedure-R.E. Good Fields

Please read carefully as there are several changes.

Full-Sided Nets and Flags (U11-U19)

We will **NO** longer leave the nets up during the season. **Both** the home team and visiting teams will now be required to set up and take down the nets and flags daily at R.E. Good.

Small-Sided Nets and Flags (U5-U8)

Both the visiting team **and** home team will now be required to set up and take down both the nets and corner flags daily at R.E. Good.

Procedure:

If you are playing at Good and you're the **home** team **and** you are the **first** game of the day it is your responsibility to go to the concession stand and retrieve the equipment. Effective immediately both **CFBSA** home and visiting teams are now required to set up the equipment. Also effectively immediately both **CFBSA** home **and** the visiting **CFBSA** team will need to take down the equipment if the game is the **last** game of the day on the field you are playing. It is still the home teams responsibility return the equipment to the storage closet. The concession stand storage closet is located between fields 2 and 3.

Never take the equipment home with you unless for some reason you are the last team and the storage closet is locked. In an emergency case, take the equipment and notify the soccer office, your league director, and vpcupgames@cfbsoccer.net immediately. CFBSA will need the equipment, probably the next day!

First/last game schedule is posted on our web-site www.cfbsoccer.net. However, if neither teams or if only one team takes the field after your game both teams must take down the equipment and the home team **must** return the equipment to the storage closet immediately after your game. As a courtesy, we ask everyone to keep the storage area clear of all litter and return the equipment to the appropriate location. If your equipment is missing do not use another field's equipment as the different age groups have different size nets. If there is missing equipment or you notice any damage please contact the soccer office at 972-245-9307 or vpcupgames@cfbsoccer.net. Field maps and field layout can be found at www.cfbsoccer.net.

You will need to come back to the field the same day if you leave the equipment up!
