



Revised - (3/29/2009) Nets and Flag Procedure-McInnish Sports Complex (Fields A-E)

If you're playing at McInnish fields and you're the **home** team, **along with** the **first** game of the day it is your responsibility to go to the concession stand retrieve any four corner flags. Effective immediately **both** teams are required to stake two corner flags. Also effectively immediately, both the home **and** the visiting team team will need to take down the equipment if the game is the **last** game of the day on the field your playing. This procedure applies to only the CFBSA teams, **not** the traveling team. It is still the home teams responsibility return all equipment the to the concession stand. The concession stand is located to the right as you enter the complex.

Never take the corner flags home with you from McInnish fields. If the concession stand is closed, leave the corner flags on the west side of the building. In this case notify the soccer office, your league director, and vpcupsgames@cfbsoccer.net the same day so CFBSA can lock up the corner flags.

First/last home game is currently posted. However, if no teams or only one team takes the field after your game, the home team must return the corner flags to the concession stand. As a courtesy we ask everyone to keep the storage area clear of all liter and return the equipment to the appropriate location. You will be needed to come back to the field the same day if you leave the equipment up.
