All referees will be paid on a weekly basis. Checks for games officiated Monday through Sunday will be processed and are ready for pickup or to be mailed on the Tuesday following Sunday (2 days).

All referees must fill out and return form W-9 to the soccer office. All W-9's **must** be directly delivered to office personnel.

Field Marshals will be assigned to monitor games on Saturdays at Cox/Pepper and Good. Please let the Field Marshals know of any unusual or abusive behavior by players, coaches or spectators.

If any of the referee team is absent or late arriving to the pitch, the center referee must notify the Field Marshal and CFBSA referee assignor (Susan Terry) immediately. If the center referee is absent, one of the assistant referees must make the notification immediately.

No swapping of games or fields occurs unless you're told to do so by the Field Marshal and/or the CFBSA referee assignor.

If you receive a paycheck that you feel is not accurate, notify the office immediately so the information may be passed on to our accounting personnel.
