Fellow Referees,

CFBSA will continue to use Got-Sport to communicate between you and CFBSA. We strongly recommend that all referees who wish to referee in CFBSA to log into Got-Sport at [https://www.gotsport.com/asp/officials/register.asp?RA\\_DirectorID=2468](https://www.gotsport.com/asp/officials/register.asp?RA_DirectorID=2468). It's free and only takes a few minutes to provide us with some basic information. To receive valuable information from us via email, you must register using the above link. This link can also be found in the referee section of [www.cfbsooccer.net](http://www.cfbsooccer.net). Register today if you've not done so as there are many changes occurring.

By creating an account through Got-Sport it allows us to communicate more efficiently and effectively with everyone. Once you provide us with the referees name and email address (es) it will allow us to email you the events taking place in the Carrollton Farmers-Branch Soccer Association and North Texas. This includes training, classes, meetings, updates, tournaments and other important topics. To begin receiving emails we need the referees names and email addresses. Other information requested is optional. Parents, we recommend that you provide us your email address as the primary email.

When you register, the "User Name" and "Password" have to be different, however YOU choose both. After you have created your initial account you can then go back to your account and add and/or delete phone numbers, emails and other data. CFBSA has utilized Got-Sport for several years in game scheduling and other functions and have had success with the applications. CFBSA uses Got-Sport for player on-line registration and have been very pleased with the program.

When you register with Got-Sport you register with CFBSA, **not** the local assignor. All CFBSA referee assignments will be done directly through our contracted referee assignor who is **not** affiliated with Got-Sport. To be assigned games at CFBSA you must first register with North Texas State Soccer Association (NTSSA) at [www.ntxsoccer.org](http://www.ntxsoccer.org) as a CFBSA referee. In addition, to provide you accurate information in a timely manner we will continually enhance the information in the referee section of [www.cfbsooccer.net](http://www.cfbsooccer.net). The information is extremely valuable and we encourage everyone to visit the site often.
