Game Report / Misconduct Form

Guidelines

(U13-U19)

- 1. The Game Report and Game Misconduct Report is one form used within Northern Mid-Cities Soccer League (Ages U13-U19)**
- 2. Each team playing a NMCSL match is required to present a completed Game/Misconduct Report (roster included) to the Center Referee prior to the game.**
- 3. The center referee will document the score and caution(s)/ejection(s) on the report with necessary details (using the back of the form as needed).**
- 4. The center referee will NOT return the report to either team at the conclusion of the game.**
- 5. The referee will tear off the bottom right corner with the final score of each report and return to each team.**
- 6. The center referee will submit the report into the “drop box” located near the “ref area” by end of the day.**

Additional Notes:

Sit-Out Verification forms are the responsibility of the coach to be provided to the Center Referee PRIOR to the game in question. The player MUST present himself/herself to the Center Referee prior to the game. The Center Referee will then sign and return the form to the coach at the conclusion of the game.
