

Player ID Badges and Photographs

Player ID Badges (U13-U19)

Players in the U13-U19 division will be required to have a players ID badge, similar to a coach's badge. No player will be allowed to play the game unless they have their ID at the game*. The referee and/or league official will check picture on ID to player. You must also check player and players jersey number so it matches the players name listed on the teams typed game report. All ID Badges must be returned to team prior to the game. **No** badges are to be kept, even if player receives a red card.

Player Photographs (U9-U19)

Beginning the Fall 2010 soccer season all players in the U9-U19 age group will be required to have a photograph on file with CFBSA. No player in these age groups will be allowed to play in any CFBSA game unless a parent or team representative inputs a photograph of the player into the team or players Got-Soccer account. The photo must be a clear shot of entire face centered in the photo. Profile shots or photos not in focus will not be accepted. The photo should be similar to a driver's license or passport picture. This photo must have been taken within 6 months of the season. The expression should be natural, with both eyes open, looking directly ahead. Photos with unusual expressions and squinting will not be accepted. A new photo will be required beginning of each soccer season. CFBSA representatives will periodically check rosters to match player with photograph

Note: In lieu of "cards", the coach can provide a league software generated roster signed by the coach and the registrar with pictures included on the form.

***ID Badges will not be required to be shown or checked on the 8/27/2011.**
