## **Game Report / Misconduct Form**

### **Guidelines**

#### **(U11-U12)**

- 1. The Game Report and Game Misconduct Report is one form used within CFBSA for teams U11-U12.**
- 2. Each U11-U12 CFBSA team is required to present a completed Game/Misconduct Report (roster included) to the Center Referee prior to the game.**
- 3. If **NO** card is given the center referee will record the score on the Game Report and RETURN the report to the coach. (new)**
- 4. If a yellow or red card is given the center referee will document the card and KEEP the Game Report. The referee will record the score and return the bottom right corner only to the coach if a card was given. (new)**
- 5. The center referee will submit the report into the “drop box” located near the “ref area” by end of the day if a card is given only.**

#### **Additional Notes:**

**Sit-Out Verification forms is the responsibility of the coach and MUST be provided to the center referee PRIOR to the game in question. The player MUST be present for the entire game and the referee will sign and return the form to the coach at the conclusion of the game. It is the responsibility of the coach to return the signed form to the team’s home association A&D chairperson. The home association A&D chairperson will submit and log the sit-out information.**

**Again, if there are no red or yellow cards issued the entire Game Report is returned to the coach.**

**North Texas roster can be substituted for a Game Report if coach does not have game report.**
