The basic eligibility requirements include:

High school graduating senior with a minimum GPA of 2.5 and one or more of the following:

- Is or has been a player within CFBSA
- Is or has been a referee, line person or coach within CFBSA
- Son or daughter of a past or present coach, referee or board member of CFBSA.

The evaluation system will take into account the applicant's contributions to the soccer association and academic achievements. A personal interview with our scholarship committee may also be required.

All awards will be distributed directly to the academic institution in the student's name after confirmation of enrollment in the fall.

Enclosed is a copy of our scholarship application. In order for an applicant to be considered for a scholarship, the completed application, essay and accompanying letters of recommendation must be postmarked or received **NO LATER THAN May 2, 2008**.
